### Who is this course for?

The TSST course is aimed at teachers with QTS in the state sector (including secondary and middle schools, FE Colleges, special schools and PRUs) who are already teaching or plan to teach some French at secondary/FE level. The course is also suitable for those returning to teaching after a career break.

For teachers meeting the criteria, this course is FREE through funding provided by the DfE and is run by the Avon Teaching School Alliance at Malmesbury School and University of Bristol.

Preparing non-specialists to teach French confidently at KS3 and through to GCSE, the course draws on up-to-date research to improve subject knowledge, pedagogy and practical skills.
